**Directive: Scholarships and Award for Excellence** 

**Category: School Programming and Student Services** 

### **PREAMBLE**

This directive has several objectives:

- 1. CSFY Post-Secondary Scholarship: to encourage CSFY students and alumni, or members of the Yukon's Francophone community, to pursue a French first language post-secondary education.
- 2. CSFY Award for Excellence: to recognize the graduate with the highest academic standing in our programs.
- 3. Official Languages Scholarship: to promote the bilingualism of students in our programs.

#### 1. CSFY POST-SECONDARY SCHOLARSHIP

#### 1.1 Directive Statement

Every fall, the CSFY will award at least one cash scholarship to a graduate from the preceding year, a former student or a member of the Yukon's Francophone community. Funding shall come from the interest earned on an account for this purpose and/or from the amount included for this purpose in the Canada-Yukon Agreement on Minority-Language Education (if an amount is included in this agreement).

Priority will be given to:

- 1. CSFY graduates and alumni;
- 2. Applicants who have not received the scholarship previously.

The total scholarship amount may be divided between several candidates.

## 1.2 Selection Criteria

- 1.2.1 Candidates must submit their application form to the CSFY at info@csfy.ca by September 15 (see Appendix 1).
- 1.2.2 Candidates must be continuing their studies or returning to study in a French first language post-secondary program recognised by a Canadian Department of Education.
- 1.2.3 Candidates must provide proof of admission to a post-secondary academic institution.
- 1.2.4 The scholarship will be granted at the CSFY Annual Meeting and will be paid out upon receipt of an official transcript for the semester which the scholarship applies to.

- 1.2.5 Scholarship recipients must agree to participate in a session with CSFY students during the year after the scholarship has been granted in order to share their stories and experiences, so as to highlight the value of a French first language secondary and post-secondary education. Depending on availability, this can be done in-person or remotely, and it may take various forms according to the needs of the CSFY.
- 1.2.6 If you graduated from a Yukon high school in an English program or a French immersion program, you are not eligible for this scholarship. We invite you to apply for the equivalent French as a Second Language (FSL) post-secondary bursary from the Department of Education, <a href="https://yukon.ca/en/education-and-schools/financial-support-students/apply-post-secondary-bursary-study-french">https://yukon.ca/en/education-and-schools/financial-support-students/apply-post-secondary-bursary-study-french</a>.

#### 2. CSFY AWARD FOR EXCELLENCE

#### 2.1 Directive Statement

At the end of each school year, the CSFY will grant a \$1000 cash award to the graduate who has obtained the highest academic standing at one of its schools.

#### 2.2 Selection Criteria

- 2.2.1 The candidate must be studying full-time, i.e. registered in a minimum of six courses during the school year, in Grade 12 at a CSFY school and meet the following requirements:
  - 2.2.1.1 Have over 75% in every course; and
  - 2.2.1.2 Have received the highest cumulative grade point average at the end of the school year (excluding government exams).

#### 3. OFFICIAL LANGUAGES SCHOLARSHIP

#### 3.1 Directive Statement

At the end of the school year, the CSFY will grant a \$1000 cash award to all graduates of its programs who have received a certificate of bilingualism from the CSFY.

## 3.2 Selection Criteria

- 3.2.1 Candidates must be studying full-time, i.e. registered in a minimum of six courses during the school year, in Grade 12 at a CSFY school and meet the following requirements:
  - 3.2.1.1 Have satisfied the requirements for receiving a secondary school diploma (Dogwood Diploma);
  - 3.2.1.2 Have successfully completed three (3) French first language courses in Grades 10 to 12.
  - 3.2.1.3 Have successfully completed three (3) English first language courses (which are equivalent to those offered at English-language schools) in Grades 10 to 12.
