

Directive: Child Care Services

Category: School Programming and Student Services

PREAMBLE

A number of CSFY families require access to child care services. The CSFY shall ensure, to the extent possible, that school-based child care services are made available.

DIRECTIVE STATEMENT

The purpose of this directive is to provide standardized regulations for school-based child care services. These functions, which take place outside of regular class time, complement the education system. The CSFY recognizes the value of child care services, provided that they meet general educational goals and correspond with its mission.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. The main objectives of school-based child care services are to:
 - 1.1 Facilitate the participation of the greatest number of students possible in the school programming;
 - 1.2 Enable the growth and development of school programs; and
 - 1.3 Provide a viable French-language alternative for parents.
2. Child care services may be offered: before classes, after classes and during Professional Development (PD) days.
3. Adequate supervision shall be provided.
4. Registration is limited to CSFY elementary school students.
